







Use this format when you are answering interview questions that start with:

"Tell me about a time when..." or "Explain a situation where..."



Describe the situation that you were in or the task that you needed to accomplish

You must describe a specific event or situation, not a generalized description of what you have done in the past

Be sure to give enough detail for the interviewer to understand











Use this format when you are answering interview questions that start with:

"Tell me about a time when..." or "Explain a situation where..."





Describe the action/approach you took and be sure to keep the focus on you

Even if you are discussing a group project or effort, describe what you did – not the efforts of the team

Don't tell what you might do, tell what you did
